Dear Parents/Carers,

We are planning our eighth sponsored walk on Friday 27th June 2025. The School Council, who meet regularly throughout the academic year, will discuss and decide how the proceeds of the sponsored walk could be used, but the intention will always be to improve the school life chances of all our pupils and their education here at Aston Fields Middle School. In previous years, our sponsored walks have helped the school to purchase additional shade sails for the school field, fund mental health and wellbeing resources and supported the addition of new books for the library.

The walk will take place around the school grounds, with all pupils walking as many laps as they can in an hour. Each lap is approximately 700m in length. Pupils with medical conditions may wish to walk for less time. Any pupils not able to complete at least one lap will have the opportunity to help in the organisation of the day to ensure this event is fully inclusive. All pupils will complete the course on the morning of Friday 27th June. In the event of severe weather, the sponsored walk will be postponed to another day. If necessary, parents/carers will be notified of this change via the MCAS app.

With the Ramble taking place in the same week as Modern Britain Day, on Tuesday 24th June, the School Council thought that we should again continue with the same theme. Therefore, we request that all pupils come to school on the Friday dressed as a famous Great Briton (past or present), or dressed in the colours of red, white and blue. Trainers will be required along with sun screen and a sunhat if the weather is forecast to be hot, and a waterproof in the event of forecast showers. Pupils will also need to bring their water bottles, which can be re-filled at water stations during the walk and any specific medical needs, such as inhalers.

For Modern Britain Day on Tuesday 24th June, pupils, if they wish, can wear a top in the colour of their house along with their normal school uniform. However, hoodies will not be allowed.

Attached to this letter is a sponsor form for the pupils to collect sponsors. We have spoken to pupils, in assembly, about the dangers of asking unfamiliar people and would ask you to reinforce this message at home. However, whilst we expect all pupils to take part in the walk, participating in the fundraising is voluntary. Sponsor money should be paid in cash in a named envelope.

We are very much looking forward to our next sponsored walk around the school grounds and we are sure that the pupils will have much fun when participating in both Modern Britain Day and the Ramble. Thank you in advance for your continued support of the school.
